good things take time.... Forager's Gin is the creation of Snowdonia Distillery which launched in 2015 with a ethos of focusing on sustainability and quality rather than quantity. Forager take six times longer than most distilleries and limit their production to just 5,000 hand numbered bottles per expression

Foragers Black

with the simplicity of two botanicals; juniper & sea blackthorn - simple, classy and crisp

ForagersYellow

soft juniper tones, which gently lead to semi-sweet apple and elderberry, ending in the floral notes of gorse and heather flower - subtle, lengthy and fragrant

Da Mhile

established in 2012 on the founders, family farm in Ceredigion, with handpicked organic seaweed from the Welsh coastline, designed to compliment seafood beautifully

MeryWen

small batch gin from Denbighshire in Wales' smallest distillery. Handcrafted 30 bottle expressions using water from the foothills of Snowdonia - the essence of Welsh spirit, best served with a slice of cucumber whilst humming Welsh folk songs

BlueSlate

from Dinorwig Distillery, made the London dry way using juniper, coriander, angelica, lemon, rosemary, bay, heather honey, rhubarb and Welsh oak bark - classic

Dyfi Distillery - situated within the Unesco World Biosphere of the Dyfi Valley, two extraordinary seasonal gins

Hibernation

aged in a fully seasoned white port barrel, with overtones of crab apples, blackberries & bilberries

Pollination

foraged botanicals from the Snowdonia foothills, through the Dyfi Forest, and down to the estuary marshlands, wild flowers, aromatic leaves, fruits and conifer tips.

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GŴYR Gin

eight botanicals including juniper, lemon zest, pink grapefruit, green fennel and bronze fennel from the Gower coast -think long golden beaches and ozone rich air - heady

The Botanist

22 island botanicals including wood sage and wild thyme foraged on the Hebridean island of Islay - it tastes wild, of the Atlantic and hedgerows and west coast seashores

Sly Gin

straight from the garden- handcrafted, small batch in the heart of Herefordshire. Filled with rich spruce like juniper aromas and deep complex herbal and spicy notes.

Aber Falls - situated at the foot of the waterfall it's named after, the lovingly restored distillery houses two incredible copper stills named Golchi and Gwirod.

Inspired by ancient flavours that evoke the Druid - rowan berry and lavender pervade

Aber Falls Ginger and Rhubarb

think Sunday dinners, family gatherings on warm autumn days, spicy topped crumble and a sharp tartiness. Fab for cocktails, sipped as a liqueur or even naughtily poured over vanilla ice cream.....

Aber Falls Orange Marmalade

sweet and bitter orange zest comes through after the piney juniper - drink it long and cold, it's fizzy refreshing and makes you think of summer
